

# Provider Tree Test Key Insights

Respondents failed 8 of the 10 tasks

Provider comments from recent survey

"I'm extremely disappointed in the changes you've made to the website. It most definitely IS NOT, user friendly!!!!"

"There' is a lot of information accessible online but it doesn't seem to be organized in a way that makes it easy for me to find what I want."

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Conduct focus groups with providers to explore new navigation
- Tree test proposed navigation
- Suggested solutions: Include "signposts" and "scent trails" in new website design to help providers find information quickly

Provider comments from recent survey

"Please update your website more quickly."

"The website is very clunky with a less than optimal user experience."

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### Overview

- Current website navigation has 8 levels
- New navigation for the provider section has been proposed with 3 levels by the internal Provider team.
- The proposed navigation was "tree tested", like a card sort, using Optimal Workshop.
- 42 OH Certified Providers participated in the remote tree test: 35 completed all 10 tasks.

#### Goals

Determine if providers can find information using the proposed navigation

Task 1 You need to file a claim and you want to know if you can do this online.

- 31% (11 of 35) of respondents succeed
- 66% (23 of 35) of respondents failed
- 3% (1 of 35) of respondents skipped

Task 2 Where would you look for the treatment guidelines used by BWC?

- No respondents succeed
- 89% (31 of 35) of respondents failed
- 11% (4 of 35) of respondents skipped

Task 3 Where would you go to find contact information on an MCO?

- 40% (14 of 35) of respondents succeed
- 54% (19 of 35) of respondents failed
- 6% (2 of 35) of respondents skipped

Task 4 Where would you look for requesting authorization for additional treatment?

- 37% (13 of 35) of respondents succeed
- 60% (21 of 35) of respondents failed
- 3% (1 of 35) of respondents skipped

Task 5 Where can you look for a medication to see if BWC covers that drug?

- 6% (2 of 35) of respondents succeed
- 80% (28 of 35) of respondents failed
- 14% (5 of 35) of respondents skipped

Task 6 Where would you go to find more information when a treatment is denied, and you want to dispute it?

- 31% (11 of 35) of respondents succeed
- 63% (22 of 35) of respondents failed
- 6% (2 of 35) of respondents skipped




Where would you look for the treatment guidelines used by BWC?



Where would you go to find contact information on an MCO?








Where would you look for requesting authorization for additional treatment?








Where can you look for a medication to see if BWC covers that drug?








Where would you go to find more information when a treatment is denied, and you want to dispute it?








Where would you go to find out about the annual training symposium for medical providers?








Where can you go to find out how to renew your BWC certification?








Where would you find the minimum criteria for become a DEP physician?








Where would you join the list for BWC's provider electronic newsletter?

#### Overview

BWC users adapted to the current website design by calling the call center for help finding information on the website.


Suggested solutions for the new website design include:

- Common searches, also called scent trails, which can help providers find information quickly
- Some websites use signposts, which are static boxes of common links, to help users find to popular pages quickly

#### Common Searches

Many websites display common search queries, also called trending searches, to help users get to the desired information quickly.

Common searches, also called scent trails, which can help providers find information quickly






Trending Searches Example
